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## GENERAL INFORMATION

**Staging of Exhibits** – All exhibits must be staged in the Home & Garden marquee on the Showground between 2pm and 6pm on Friday 13th July 2018. Stewards will be on site to assist you with this. Judging will take place at 7pm and only Stewards and Judges will be permitted access to the marquee at this time.

**Show Tickets** – Adult exhibitors making 8 or more entries in their own name will receive a complimentary Show Ticket. Children under 16 years of age are admitted free of charge. If you are eligible for a complimentary ticket it will be despatched to you two weeks prior to the Show.

**Vehicle Passes** – All vehicles will require a valid vehicle pass to enter the Showground to drop off and pick up exhibits. This will be despatched to you two weeks prior to the Show and must be displayed clearly.

**Collection of exhibits** – This may be done after 6pm on Sunday 15th July or on Monday 16th July between 9am and 6pm.

**Online Entry** – Online entry is available via our website [www.yeovilshow.org](http://www.yeovilshow.org).

**Stewards** – The Yeovil Show is indebted to its team of Stewards who volunteer to help plan, prepare and run the Show. Without their dedication we would not be able to run any of our competitions. # RULES AND REGULATIONS

## GENERAL COMPETITION RULES

1. **Entries** - All entries must be on an official entry form or via the online entry system and signed by exhibitor, owner, agent or if under 16 years of age, the exhibitor and parent/guardian. All exhibits must be owned by the exhibitor at the time of making entries. This rule obviously is superseded where exhibits are required to be bred, made or produced by the exhibitor
2. **Closing Dates** - No entries will be accepted after the relevant closing date.
3. **Refunds** - No refunds can be made for any entry after the relevant closing date.
4. **Safety** - Exhibitors are reminded to comply with all safety regulations relating to themselves, their exhibits and the public.
5. **Accidents** - The Show will not be responsible for any loss, illness, damage or accident that may occur to any animal or article exhibited at the Show. It is a condition of entry that the exhibitor shall hold the Show harmless and indemnify it against any legal proceedings arising from any such accident, loss or illness. All accidents must be reported to the Show Office.
6. **Prizes** - As printed in the schedule except where the Judge or Section Chairman reserves the right to change for whatever reason. The Judge need not award a first prize.
7. **Prize Money** - To be collected on the day of the Show. No prize money is given unless the relevant Prize Money Collection Card is handed in. No prize money is sent out, unless requested in writing with the relevant Prize Money Collection Card attached (unless stated in the schedule).
8. **Judging** - No public will be allowed in the judging rings or marquees whilst judging is in progress. The Judge's decision is final. The decision of the Show on any point not covered by the rules is final.
9. **Refusal of Entries** - The Show reserves the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason.
10. **Entry Tickets** - Each person must give up an admission ticket when entering the Showground on Show days. Should exhibitors be entitled to exhibitor or vehicle passes these will be dispatched, two weeks prior to the Show.
11. **Objections** - An exhibitor making an objection shall do so in writing to the Event Director before 4.00pm (or at close of judging) on the relevant day of the Show, and shall deposit the sum of £50. The objector must be an exhibitor in the same class. The Show will decide the outcome by 5.00pm that day and in the event of an objection being held invalid the said sum of £50 shall be forfeited to the Show.
12. **Security** - 24-hour security is on site from 12 noon on the Wednesday prior to the Show until 12 noon Tuesday after the Show. The Show cannot accept responsibility for any loss, theft or damage.
13. **Showground Facilities** - Refreshments, toilets and showers are available on the Showground. Exhibitors are allowed to use the Judges and Stewards facilities after 5.30pm on Friday and Saturday where the catering and bars operate until 11.00pm.
14. **Access to the Showground** - Exhibitors are asked to follow the directional signs to the Showground and to allow adequate time for entry to the Show site, parking and unloading of their entries.
15. **Opening Hours** - Public opening hours are from 9.00am to 6.00pm. A security and noise curfew is in place after 11.00pm on Friday, Saturday and Sunday of Show weekend.
16. **Car and Lorry Parks** - Spaces will be allocated by the Parking Steward and should any vehicle be discovered parked in any other area it will be towed away to the car parking area.
17. **Smoking** - The Show operates a no smoking rule in all marquees, judging rings and in the Main Ring.
18. **Veterinary & Medical Cover** - These are on site via the Show Office between 8.00am and 6.00pm on Show days, after which a call out service is available. Exhibitors are responsible for any treatment costs incurred.
19. **Timing of Classes** - Competitors must present themselves to the judging rings in adequate time for the relevant competition.
20. **Mobile Phones** - No mobile phones are permitted in the Judging Areas or Grand Parade.

## HOME & GARDEN RULES

1. **Delivery/Collection of Exhibits** - Exhibits must be in place no later than 6pm on Friday 13th July 2018 and should not be removed prior to 6pm on Sunday 15th July 2018.
2. **Disposal of Exhibits** - The Show reserves the right to dispose of entries not collected before 6pm on Monday 16th July unless arrangements have been made with the Show Office.
3. **Exhibits** - All exhibits must have been grown by or be the work of the Exhibitor.
